FAQs

Q: How do I register more than one archer? A: Online – Repeat process as many times as needed per archer. By mail, Fill out a registration page and waiver per archer. Fees can be combined on check payment.

Q: Can I wear Camo? A: It is generally discouraged on clothing items for target archery, but it is only prohibited for broadcast or livestreamed events. Camo clothing and denim in good condition is acceptable for this event as it will not be broadcast. See clarification at <https://www.usarchery.org/events/rules>

Q: What is my merit class and why does it matter? A: The JOAD Achievement Class (merit) is a classification of skill level based upon the archer’s current scores. See matrix at <https://www.usarchery.org/resources/joad-indoor-achievement-scoring-matrix-250319072309.pdf> . We ask that the archers be classified by the class most fitting for their skill level prior to the event in order to create a fair and fun competition for the merit class competition. If you’re a JOAD archer and are not in a club participating in the Merit Pin program, please pick the appropriate one based upon the matrix and your most recent scoring. Alternatively, you can advise the event scorekeeper to place you in a class based upon your performance at the event.

Q: Can I purchase shirts after I’ve already registered. A: Yes, you can do a separate shirt order by order deadline. The shirt orders will be distributed at check-in time at the event.

Q: Will there be equipment inspections prior to the shoot? A-Yes, USA Archery Certified judges will be inspecting equipment during entry to the shooting area. Refer to World Archery Book3 Chapter 11 available by rule link above.

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Waiver: Please complete and sign one per archer.

In consideration of my minor being allowed to participate in any('Activity') with the Crowfoot JOAD state shoot, I agree:

1. I understand the nature of the Crowfoot JOAD state shoot activities and acknowledge the minor's experience and capabilities and believe the minor is qualified to participate in such Activity. I further acknowledge that I am aware that the activity will be conducted in facilities open to the public during the activity. I further agree and warrant that if, at any time, I believe conditions to be unsafe; I will instruct the minor to immediately discontinue further participation in the activity.
2. I fully understand that (a) Crowfoot JOAD activities involve risks and dangers of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis and death (Risks); (b) these risks and dangers may be caused by the minor's own actions. Or inactions, the actions or inactions of other participating in the activity, the condition in which the activity takes place or the negligence of the "releases" named below; (c) there may be other risks and social and economic losses either not know to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I fully accept and assume all such risks and all responsibility for losses, costs, and damages incurred as a result of my Minor's participation in the activity.

I hereby release, discharge, covenant not to sue, and agree to hold harmless Crowfoot JOAD, their respective administrators, directors, agents, officers, volunteers, and other participants, any sponsors or, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises on which the activity takes place(each considered one of the "releases" herein) from all liability, claims, damages on my minor's account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the "releases" or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations and further agree that if, despite this release, the minor or anyone on the minor's behalf makes a claim against any of the releases named above, I will indemnify, save and hold harmless each of the releases from any litigation expenses, attorney fees, loss liability, damage or cost any may incur as the result of any such claim.

I have read this agreement, fully understand and it's terms, understand that I have gave up substantial rights by signing it and have signed it freely without any inducement or assurance of any nature and intend it to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by the law and agree that if any portion of this agreement is held to be invalid that the balance, not withstanding, shall continue in full force and effect.

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MINI OLYMPIC ROUND

The participants in the Mini Olympic Round are determined by the Archer's total score, by class, during the first half of the Annual Pennsylvania JOAD State Indoor Championship. When the Archers have finished shooting ten ends (30 arrows), their scores will be collected and the placement for the Mini Olympic Round will be determined.

Mini Olympic Round Classes: Male and Female separated for Barebow/Compound/Recurve in each of the following classes – U10(Yeoman), U13, U15, U18, U21.

The top four (4) finishers, by total score in the first half of the State Indoor Championship, from each class will compete against each other in the Mini Olympic Round: #4 vs #1; #3 vs #2. The winners of the first match will compete to determine the champion. Each archer will shoot three (3) ends of (3) arrows for a total of nine (9) arrows per round.

There will be only one (1) winner per class/division - Male/Female; Barebow/Recurve/Compound for each class – U10, U13, U15, U18, and U21. NOTE: The winners of the Olympic Round may differ from the Pennsylvania JOAD Indoor Champion.

It is estimated that each end will take approximately eight (8) minutes to shoot and score. Therefore, the Mini Olympic Round should be concluded in approximately forty-five (45) minutes. At the conclusion of the Mini Olympic Round, the awards for the JOAD and the Mini Olympic Rounds will be awarded.

In the event that there is a tie for entrance into the Olympic round, the 10's & 9's Tiebreakers will be used. During the Olympic Round, a single arrow shoot off will be conducted. If the arrow score is equal, the closest to the center will be deemed the winner. The determination of the Chief Official is final.

If there are less than 4 archers competing in any of the classes/divisions: A competition will be performed until a champion is declared. If there are only three (3) archers, the top seeded archer will be given a bye in the first round. If there are only two (2) archers, then there will be only one (1) round to determine a champion. Only classes with more than one participant will have a Mini Olympic Round.

VOLUNTEERS TO ASSIST WITH THE PA JOAD INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIP AND THE OLYMPIC ROUND ARE NEEDED. If you are interested and able to help, stop at the JOAD Championship table in the Farm Show Complex.

Remember, we are all here to help the young archers experience the thrill of archery. Sportsmanship is our guiding principle. Good luck to everyone.

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
