- All **OUT of STATE** archers need to register as a **GUEST**
- We will be having In-State awards and Out of State awards
- JOAD PA States - Friday @ 4pm. & Saturday 4pm.
- PA States- Saturday & Sunday 8am, 12pm
- Late registration Dec. 23rd
- Registration will close Jan. 3rd
- Registration fee is \$35.
- Late registration is \$40. Starting Dec. 23rd
- There will be no unofficial practice.
- Official practice will be 3 end.
- Lancaster- Main Shooting Range & Shooting Center will be used for tournament
- Chieftain – Downstairs Range and Upstairs lanes will be used for tournament.
- Must follow CDC guidelines on social distancing & wearing of masks
- All participants are required to wear a mask when not actively shooting.
- Minors (under 18 yrs. of age) & Para Archers may be accompanied by 1 guardian
- No other spectators will be admitted. (Subject to change).
- All participants will be required to agree to a waiver during registration.
- Mandatory temperature checks upon entering buildings
- Lancaster Archery & Chieftain is a Non-Smoking Facility
- There will be no check-in upon arrival. Check website for target assignments.
- There will be double scoring. Lancaster will have electronic scoring along with a scorecard. Scorecard is official. Chieftain will have paper scorecards.
- Equipment inspection will be completed before shooting begins
- Parking:
 - LAS Archery parking lot is limited. Please follow signs for additional parking.
 - Chieftain Parking. Follow signs to parking area.
- Food:
 - LAS has vending machines.
 - Chieftain will be offering pre-packaged food and drinks.
- Food will be allowed in the shooting range but not past the shooting line.
- FAOP will communicate prior to the event procedures for entering and exiting the building safely
- Awards will be mailed.
- Refunds will have a service charge.
- No bow case storage. It is recommended to assemble bow before entering the building.

- Distance will be 18 meters
- PA States-Recurve Archers have a choice of a 40cm single-spot or vertical recurve 3-spot
- PA States-Compound Archers have a choice of a 40cm single-spot or vertical compound 3-spot.
- PA Divisions:
 - Recurve, Recurve Guest, Compound, Compound Guest, Barebow, Barebow Guest, Para and Bowhunter Collegiate Archers
- PA Classifications:
 - Senior, Master 50+, Master 60+, Master 70+
- **ALL Compound** archers will shoot inner ten ring
- **ALL Recurve** archers will shoot outer ten ring
- We will be hosting a "A "& "B" line
- One archer per target bale, per line
- Will have 2 minutes to shoot 3 arrows
- Will have 10sec. to go from waiting line to shooting line.
- Will be following World archery rules
- NO CAMO will be permitted

Pa State JOAD Championship: Jan. 8 or 9, 2021 @ 4pm.

- Distance will be 18 meters, except Yeoman @ 9 meter
- PA States-Recurve Archers have a choice of a 40cm single-spot or vertical 3-spot
- PA States-Compound Archers have a choice of a 40cm single-spot or vertical 3-spot.
- PA JOAD Divisions:
 - Recurve, Recurve Guest, Compound, Compound Guest, Barebow, Barebow Guest,
- PA JOAD Classifications:
 - Yeoman 9m or 18m, Bowman, Cub, Cadet and Junior
- **ALL Compound** archers will shoot inner ten ring
- **ALL Recurve** archers will shoot outer ten ring
- We will be hosting a "A "& "B" line
- One archer per target bale, per line
- Will have 2 minutes to shoot 3 arrows
- Will have 10sec. to go from waiting line to shooting line.
- Will be following World archery rules
- NO CAMO will be permitted
